




What does the AUK website do?

- Supports individual riders
 - Enter events (Perms and Calendar events)
 - Enter DIY and ECE events
 - Collects money
- Supports event organisers
 - Planning dates
 - Involves Event Delegates
 - Download start list / Upload finishers list
- Legitimises the audax sport
 - Records ACP Homologation numbers

... and keeps records

- AUK Club selection



Why does AUK need a new website?


- Aukweb has grown over a period of years and is difficult to maintain and modify.
- Aukweb is based on an old version of PHP. Upgrading to a new version is a big job.
- Aukweb is complex, and needs a lot of time from skilled individuals.
- AUK is very fortunate in having had volunteers supporting the site, but this can not continue.

The Strategy

- Commercial provider
- Not BIG BANG
- Gradual change
- Preserve the fall back path
- Minimum amount of change to aukweb


Starting Point (before new website)

- 2018
- Linkage from aukweb to Audax Forum to set Forum password
- Only registered users on the Forum
- Members and Guests use aukweb
- Some member only functions




Phase 1 – new front end

- Audax.uk established
- Static pages moved to new site
- List of calendar events
 - Uses Aukweb behind the scenes
- List of permanent events
 - Uses Aukweb behind the scenes
- Links back to Aukweb
 - DIYs and ECEs
 - Results




Phase 2 – Membership

- Build new database
- Migrate information from aukweb to audax.uk
- All member admin on new website
- Improved payment processing
- Arrange for synchronisation to support
 - Calendar rides
 - DIY, ECE, Perms
- Support individual event calendars



Phase 3 – Everything Else


- Extend database to include
 - Calendar Rides
 - Perm Rides
 - Results
- Support Event Organiser functions
- Support Event Organiser administration
- Support DIY, ECE and Perms
- Support Perm Organiser administration
- Embed DIY validator




Timing considerations

- Aukweb consumes volunteer effort to keep it running
- Audax.uk consumes money for development
- Spending time clarifying and refining requirements will result in saved development time/effort
- Avoid disrupting year end renewals (December)

Changes you will notice (Phase 2)

- Login with email address, not membership number
- Your membership number will no longer have a prefix letter
- You will need to reset your password
- More self service
 - Household member management
- Integration of Direct Debits
- Ability to register without a paid membership
- Restriction of areas of the website to members only
- The link with Audax Forum will be broken different

Changes you will <u>NOT</u> notice (Phase 2)

• Membership administrators will have more time to ride their bikes

Changes you will notice (Phase 3) **PROVISIONAL**

- 'Date last ridden' for Perms
- More consistent event information
- Online entry for under 18s
- Limits on the number of entrants
- Lottery system for over-subscribed events
