	except that minimum speed up to 600 km will be 14.3 km/h.
1.4	A maximum of three intermediate controls is permitted between the start/finish of the extension portion and

1.5	Routing between controls may be 'advisory' (left to the rider's choice on the ride), or 'mandatory' (route
