

**Regulations for Events classified as Permanents
(to be read in conjunction with Regulations for All events,
and Regulations for BP or BR events as appropriate)**

1	Permanent events are for individual cyclists, and may be ridden on any date, agreed in advance between rider and organizer. Routes and controls are set by an organiser.
1.1	Routing between controls is may be ‘advisory’ (by default), or ‘mandatory’. Mandatory routing is validated exclusively by means of a recorded GPS tracklog. GPS track logs may also be used by agreement with the organizer on advisory routes as alternative to conventional paper Proofs-of-passage.
1.2	Permanents are additionally classified as either BR or BP and adopt speed & distance limitation of those categories.
1.3	Rides may be of any distance but can only be registered and validated at the standard distances: In increments of 50 km up to 200 km and in increments of 100 km thereafter.
1.4	For rides by AUK members validated as BR, AUK distance points are awarded at a rate of 1 point for each 100 km of distance.
1.5	The organiser may submit the event for assessment of AAA points, which are awarded to members for validated rides.
