

Regulations for AUK Events classified BRM (to be read in conjunction with Regulations for all events)

1	Brevets de Randonneurs Mondiaux (BRM) are calendar events for individual cyclists. Routes and controls are set by an organiser. They are additionally validated by ACP.
2	Distances and time limits for completion are as set down by ACP
2.1	To be classified as BRM the organiser must supply sufficient details for the ride to be included in ACP's BRM calendar published annually.
2.2	Only the standard distances may be organised.
2.3	Distances must not be more than 5% over the standard distances.
2.4	The maximum time limits for BRM events at each of the standard distances are: - 200 km within 13h30; - 300 km within 20h00; - 400 km within 27h00; - 600 km within 40h00; - 1000 km within 75h00.
2.5	Minimum overall speeds for intermediate control closing times calculation shall be: for events registered as 200 to 600 km – 15 km/h; for events registered as 1000km – 13 1/3 km/h.
2.6	For validated rides by AUK members, AUK distance points are awarded at a rate of 1 point for each 100 km.
2.7	The organiser may submit the event for assessment of AAA points, which are awarded to members for validated rides
