

**Regulations for Events classified as DIY (effective from 18<sup>th</sup> February 2026)  
(to be read in conjunction with Regulations for all AUK Events and Regulations  
for BP or BR events as appropriate)**

<b>1</b>	<b>DIY are events for individuals where riders define their own ride date and control details.</b>
1.1	DIY events are additionally classified as either BR or BP and adopt the speed and distance limitation of those categories, except that the minimum speed up to 600 km will be 14.3 km/h for BR events.
1.2	Controls must be submitted to and agreed by the organiser in advance of the ride
1.3	Routing between controls may be 'advisory' (left to the rider's choice on the ride), or 'mandatory' (route submitted in advance to organiser and which rider must then follow). Mandatory routing is validated exclusively by means of a recorded GPS tracklog. GPS tracklogs may also be used on advisory routes as an alternative to conventional paper proofs-of-passage
1.4	Rides may be of any distance but may only be registered and validated at the standard distances: In increments of 50 km up to 200 km and in increments of 100 km thereafter.
1.5	The ride distance for advisory routes is taken to be the aggregate shortest rideable distance between the nominated controls.
1.6	Where validation is by means of GPS track, the rider may request submission of the event for assessment of AAA points which, if awarded, are added to the member's record of the ride.
