

## Regulations for Events classified as Permanents (effective from 18<sup>th</sup> February 2026)

(to be read in conjunction with Regulations for all AUK Events and Regulations for BP or BR events as appropriate)

1	<b>Permanent events are for individual cyclists, and may be ridden on any date, agreed in advance between rider and organiser. Routes and controls are set by an organiser.</b>
1.1	Routing between controls may be 'advisory' (by default), or 'mandatory'. Mandatory routing is validated exclusively by means of a recorded GPS tracklog. GPS tracklogs may also be used by agreement with the organiser on advisory routes as an alternative to conventional paper proofs-of-passage.
1.2	Permanents are additionally classified as either BR or BP and adopt speed and distance limitation of those categories.
1.3	Rides may be of any distance but may only be registered and validated at the standard distances: In increments of 50 km up to 200 km and in increments of 100 km thereafter.
1.4	The organiser may submit the event for assessment of AAA points, which are awarded to members for validated rides.
